

Directions to the Dunne Park Clubhouse

If you are using an interactive app on your phone or car's system to navigate as you drive, plug in "600 West Street, Hollister CA" and let it work for you. The written description below is for those who want to check things out in advance or have a better understanding of the alternatives.

The verbose version:

Assuming you are driving from Gilroy or further north or south of San Juan Bautista, there are three main entry paths:

1) Highway 101 Southbound via CA Hwy 25 to Hollister

Drive south from Gilroy and **take the CA Hwy 25 exit to Hollister**. Proceed through the turbo roundabout staying on 25 and continue until you reach the stoplit intersection with San Felipe Road with a **right turn lane going onto San Felipe** to Downtown Hollister. San Felipe changes its name to San Benito Street as you head toward downtown.

Turn right at the intersection of San Benito and Fourth Street. Currently a flashing red light.

Go two blocks on Fourth Street and **turn left on West Street**.

Go two Blocks on West Street until you reach Sixth Street. You will be facing a white adobe building with an arched front porch. This is the Dunne Park Clubhouse. The address is 600 West Street. Park on the street, preferably on the park side and enter the multi-paned window door facing the diagonal walk to the building center.

2) Highway 101 exiting to CA Hwy 152 eastbound in Gilroy

CA Hwy 152 enters Gilroy in north Gilroy and jogs south on Hwy 101 to south Gilroy then going to the east. Hwy 152 East on the east side of Gilroy becomes 10th Street on the west side of 101. To go to Hollister via 152 get on 152 East heading away from Gilroy, There are two routes with further options (a road network).

The first option, and the most used by far, is to **turn right off of 152 at Frazier Lake Road**, a stoplit intersection with a right turn lane after the large food processing plant (onion and garlic dehydrator). Drive south on Frazier Lake crossing Bloomfield Road (turning right on Bloomfield will take you to Hwy 25). Continue south on Frazier Lake until you reach Shore Road.

Turn left onto Shore Road and continue to Dunneville Corners (Same Dunne) with a Restaurant/small grocery store.

Turn right onto San Felipe Road. Continue on San Felipe crossing Hwy 156 and Hwy 25. San Felipe changes its name to San Benito Street as you head toward downtown.

Turn right at the intersection of San Benito and Fourth Street. Currently a flashing red light.

Go two blocks on Fourth Street and **turn left on West Street.**

Go two Blocks on West Street until you reach Sixth Street. You will be facing a white adobe building with an arched front porch. The is the Dunne Park Clubhouse. The address is 600 West Street. Park on the street, preferably on the park side, and enter the multi-paned window door facing the diagonal walk to the building center.

The Second Option, and also the long way on Hwy 152 is to drive on 152 until it intersects Hwy 156 from Hollister. **Take the right turn exit off of 152 onto 156 west toward Hollister.** Drive on 156 until you reach the stoplight at San Felipe and **turn left onto San Felipe.** You then follow the instructions above under the first Option into downtown Hollister and to Dunne Park. This route is only an escape hatch when you learn that all the other routes are very slow.

The various network roads, include turning right from Frazier Lake Road onto Shore Road, toward Hwy 25 and turning left onto 25 (can be a long wait for a gap on 25) and zigs and zags on Bloomfield and Bolsa roads. File these as something to know but rarely use.

3) Highway 101 exiting to CA Hwy 156 eastbound via San Juan Bautista

This path to Hollister and Dunne Park is for those coming from Hwy 101 either from the north or south. For those coming from the north, it is much longer than the Hwy 101 to Hwy 25 route or the Hwy 152 first option (Frazier Lake Road . . .). I include it for completeness and to possibly suggest going home that way with a meal on the way for those who have never been to San Juan Bautista. It has the benefit of having the newest road where the construction is now completed.

Drive down Hwy 101 South from Gilroy or north to the CA Hwy 156 East exit to San Juan Bautista. Stay on 156 through San Juan and continue the length of the San Juan Valley (including a plain new roundabout) and **Turn right onto what is now called Fourth Street** toward downtown Hollister (used to be named San Juan Road for about three more miles).

Continue into Hollister until you reach West Street (Powell Street is one block before West). **Turn right onto West Street.**

Go two Blocks on West Street until you reach Sixth Street. You will be facing a white adobe building with an arched front porch. The is the Dunne Park Clubhouse. The address is 600 West Street. Park on the street, preferably on the park side and enter the multipaned window door facing the diagonal walk to the building center.
