By-Laws Ratification by the Membership

~~(1) He/she changes residence to a place outside the jurisdiction of the Unit~~

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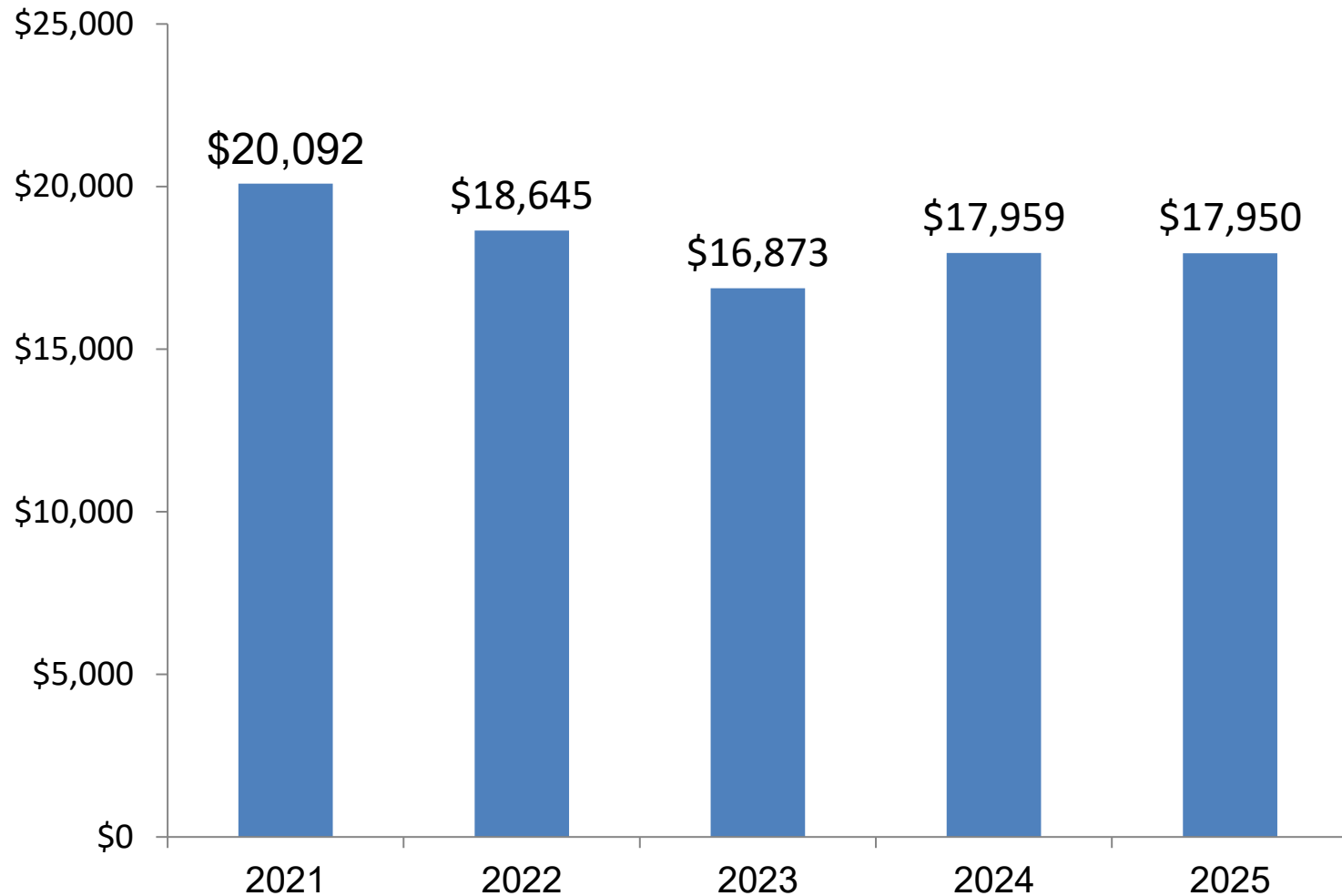
- A. The affairs of the Unit shall be managed and conducted by the Unit Board of Directors which shall consist of ~~five~~ a minimum of 4 persons, all of whom must be members of the Unit.
- B. Each director shall hold office for a period of ~~two~~ one year (coinciding with calendar years). ~~Two directors shall be elected in odd numbered years and the three directors shall be elected in even numbered years.~~ Directors shall be elected on an annual basis at the annual unit meeting in December.
- C. Candidates for Director shall be nominated and elected from and by the membership of the Unit. Candidates for Director should be nominated from certain geographic areas to represent the membership composition of the Unit.
 - 1. Each year the President shall appoint a Nominating Committee composed of ~~three~~ two persons, only one of whom shall be a member of the current Board of Directors. This committee shall nominate a slate of persons willing to serve on the Board of Directors. The committee shall make its report at the annual meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor with the nominee's permission.

The ~~Secretary~~ Treasurer shall keep an inventory list of Unit equipment

ARTICLE XI -DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of Unit # 524, any assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to a nonprofit organization which has an established tax-exempt status under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code and which is operated primarily to advance the game of bridge .

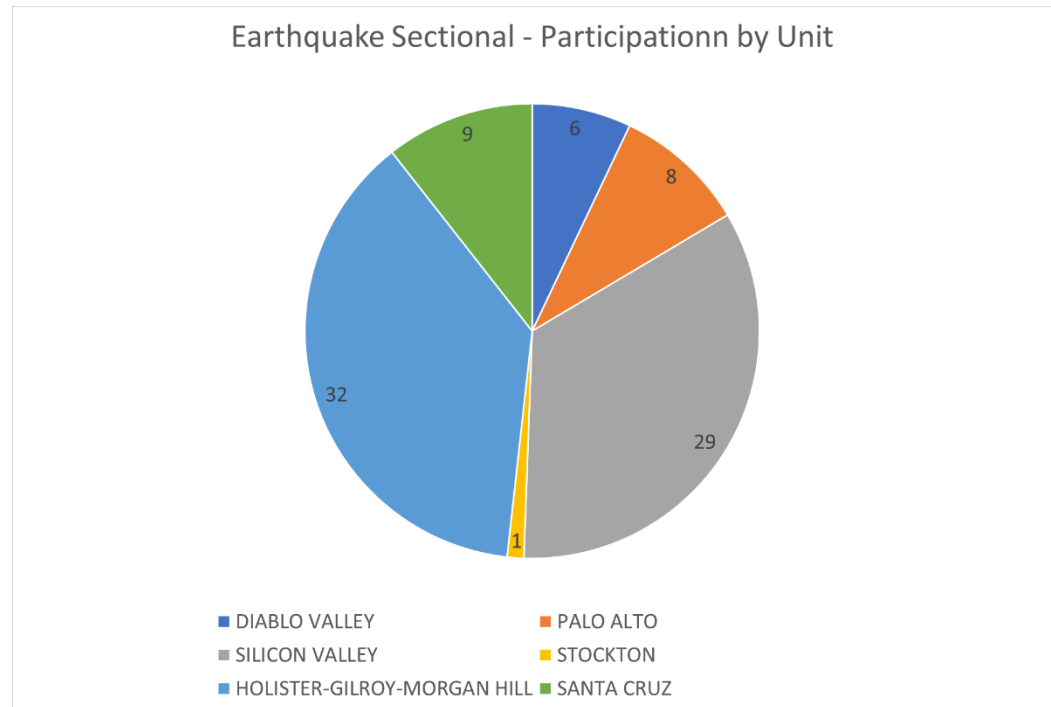
